

Women's Inter-Cultural Exchange Mentoring Across Difference

The *Mentoring Across Difference* program was designed to:

- a) Building trust across gender, generation, race, culture, socio-economics, and disability;
- b) Compliment the students' leadership and development skills while allowing them access to senior level men and women in the community;
- c) Provide an opportunity for students to receive guidance from leaders they might not normally be able to access; and
- d) Ensure that promising students are nurtured by others who are willing to share their time, experiences and formulas for success in a global society.

As a mentor, you will provide your mentee with access to your wealth of experience in the workforce and wisdom gathered throughout your life around a variety of topics --from the importance of education to how to navigate the working environment. I hope each of you considers becoming a mentor this year, the requirements are simple.

- Agree to a one-year commitment;
- Be available to mentor at least 3 hours per month (September - April) for face time -- each pair can work out schedule and other ways of communicating;
- Attend both the Mentor/Mentee Orientation (September) and the Program Celebration Luncheon;
- Attend 3 of the 6 professional development opportunities offered throughout the year;
- Be a financial supporter of the Mentoring Across Difference program at \$25.00 or above;
- Fill out an eligibility questionnaire and interview with the Program Committee before being assigned a mentee.
- Mentors are also encouraged, but are not required to join Vision 2020 member (levels: \$20.20 or \$202.00 or \$2020.00).
